


STEP 1. Choose your music. You will need to choose three or more songs for this project. Songs MUST be appropriate for school (no bad words or inappropriate themes)

Songs should be something representing your past (maybe a song you liked when you were little), present (a song that describes you now), and a vision of your future (like something that represents what you think your future holds).


You can use your own personal playlist to download songs to your Google drive, search on YouTube or another streaming service to insert a song into your presentation, or choose another way to search for songs. (Reminder: You may only use School-Appropriate Songs - no bad words or inappropriate topics in the songs)






STEP 2. Decide how you are going to make your presentation. You can create a powerpoint or Google Slideshow, or use any type of presentation you wish. You can even copy blank slides from this presentation to use for yours.


STEP 3. Write your script. The script is your personal narration of your musical autobiography. Tell why you chose those songs and what they mean to you.



STEP 4. Create your presentation. Create an entertaining and engaging presentation telling us about yourself using the songs. This should be the "soundtrack of your life." It should be about 5 minutes long, and include a script written by you. You can even record yourself reading the script while the music is playing.









# My Musical Autobiography

### "Livin' On A Prayer" by Bon Jovi




