




My Musical Autobiography - the Soundtrack to My Life


A “soundtrack” is like the background music that makes a movie or show or story sound fantastic. For this project - the story is YOUR life! You will choose three or more songs that illustrate your Past, Present, and a vision of your Future.

STEP 1. Choose your music.
You will need to choose three or more songs for this project.
Songs MUST be appropriate for school (no bad words or inappropriate themes)



Songs should be something representing your **past** (maybe a song you liked when you were little), **present** (a song that describes you now), and a vision of your **future** (like something that represents what you think your future holds).




Once you have chosen your music, type the titles in this text box



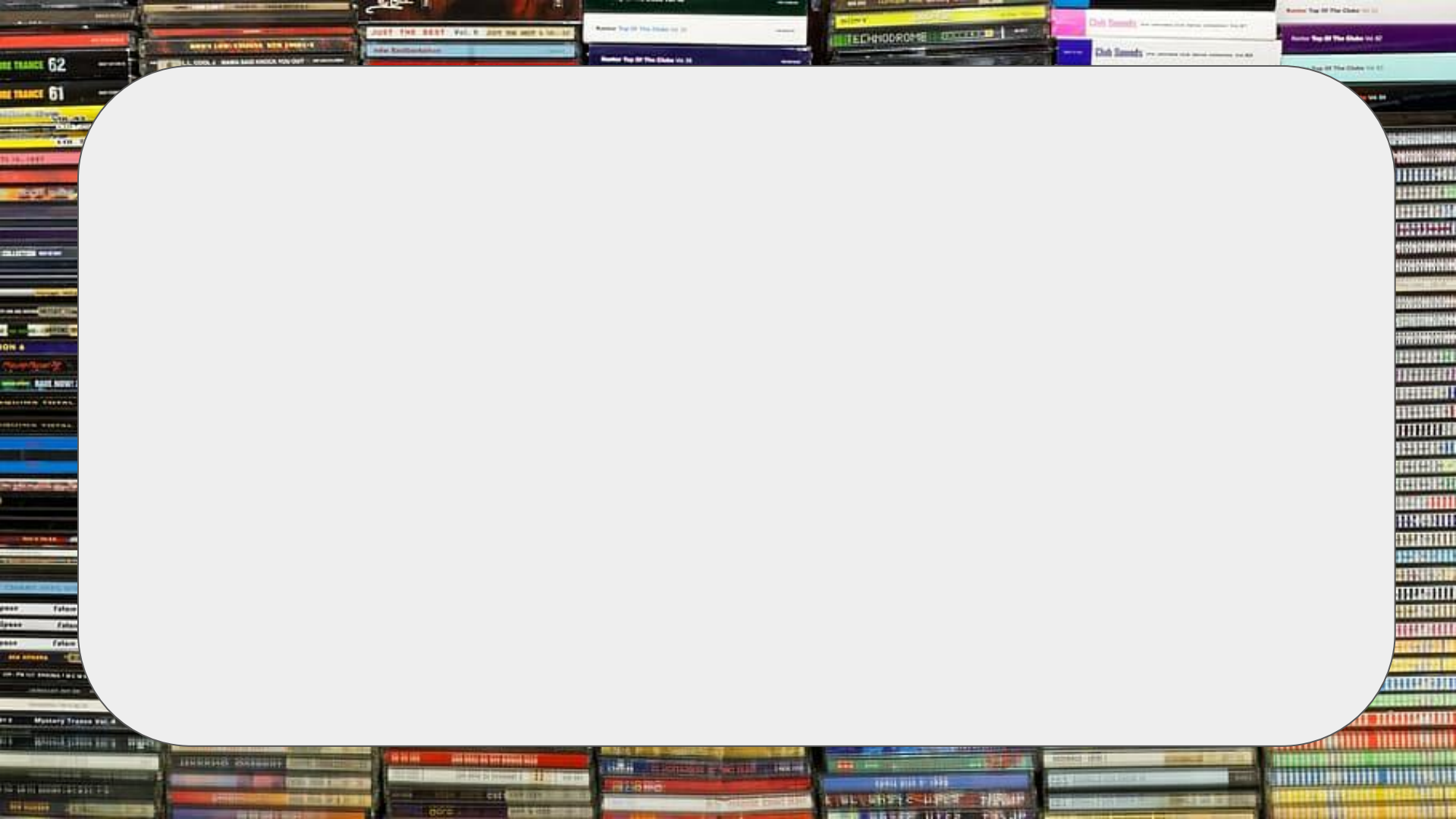
STEP 4. Create your presentation.

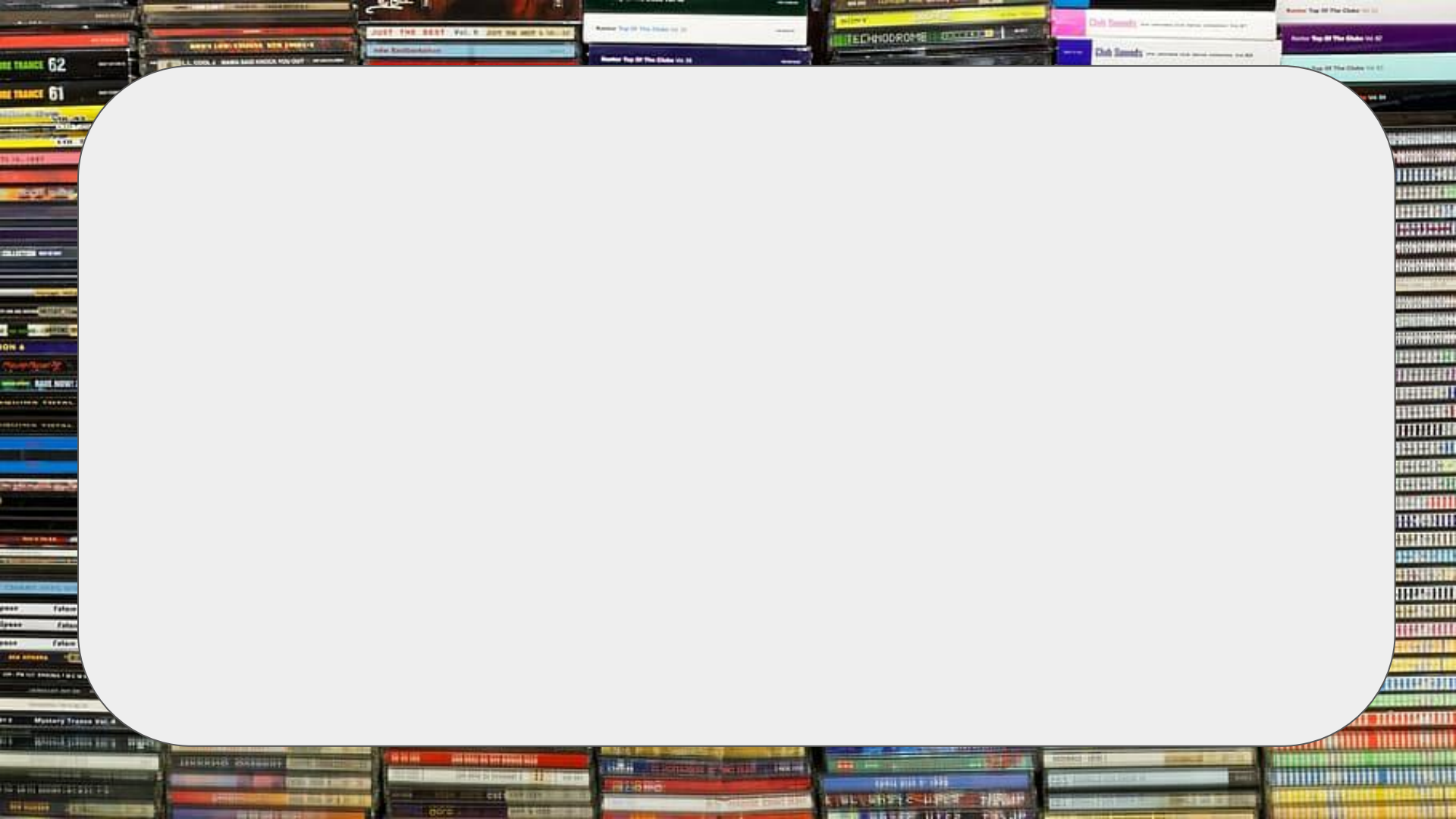

You may duplicate slides from this presentation to begin, or you can create your own slides or use another kind of presentation..

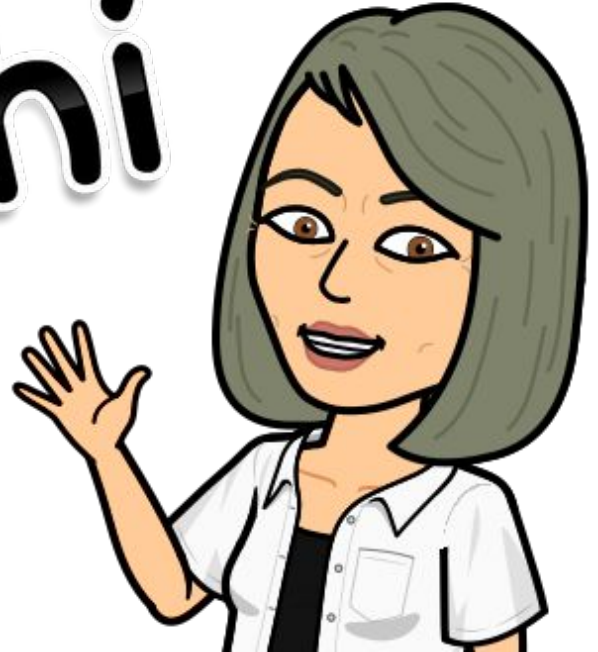

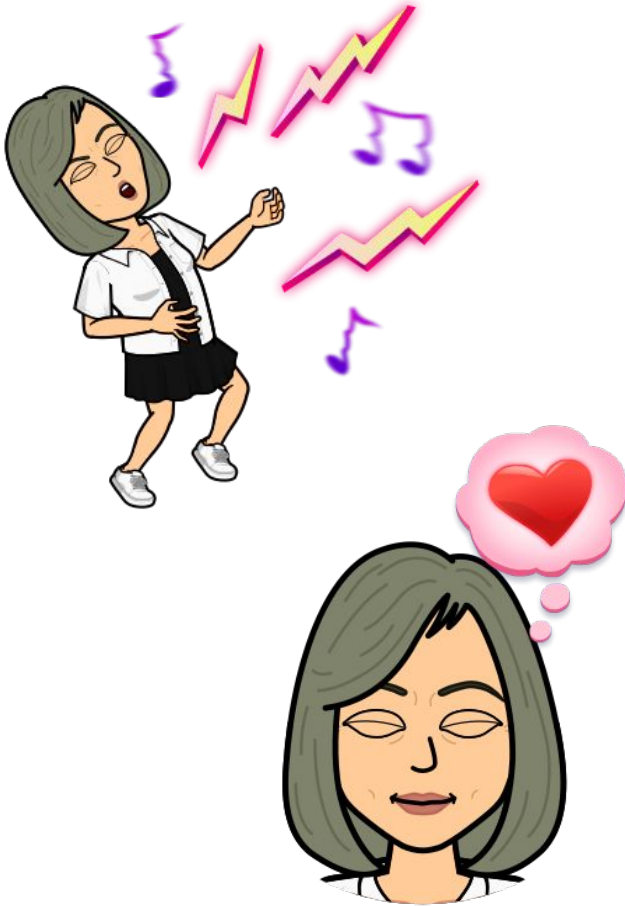

I chose this song because I LOVED Bon Jovi when MTV first came out (still do!). I hear this song a LOT when I am working out these days, so everything old is new again!

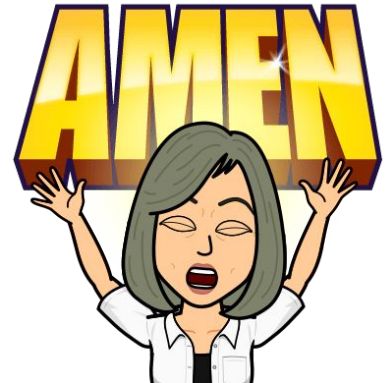
“Livin’ On A Prayer” by Bon Jovi
