The score is for a concert band and includes the following parts: Flute, Oboe, Bassoon, B♭ Clarinet 1, B♭ Clarinet 2, Bass Clarinet, Alto Sax, Tenor Sax, Bari Sax, B♭ Trumpet 1, B♭ Trumpet 2, Horn in F, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba, Mallets 1, Mallets 2, Mallets 3, and Mallets 4. The music is in 4/4 time and begins with a *Cantabile* tempo of approximately 80 beats per minute. It All Begins With Music

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Flute

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Alto Sax
